The Kingston Fencing Club, along with the Veteran's Division of the Canadian Fencing Federation, the Ontario Fencing Association, the City of Kingston, and Queen's University, proudly welcomes participants to the first annual CAN/AM Veteran's Cup.

The City of Kingston, nestled in the scenic 1000 Islands tourist area, was the first national capital of Canada. Now known for its historic limestone buildings, its surrounding natural beauty, fine dining, and exciting night life, Kingston is a very popular tourist destination. Located conveniently half-way between Toronto and Montreal, two hours south of the Ottawa International Airport and two hours north of the Syracuse airport, Kingston is easily accessible by car, train or airplane. Norman Rogers Airport is located 15 minutes west of downtown.

Accommodations

Queen's University, the venue for this year's tournament, is located close to the downtown area. The University was established in 1841 and has a magnificent campus with limestone buildings. The venue is located in the main gym of the Athletic Recreation Centre (ARC). This new multi million dollar complex boasts state of the art facilities.

The University is also the site for the awards ceremony banquet and low-cost accommodations. Each two bedroom suite (with a double bed) has a shared bathroom in the modern and recently built Leggett Hall residence building. Breakfast and lunch are affordable and can be found near the residence building.

For those wishing more luxurious accommodations Kingston offers many upscale hotels. A group booking of 25 rooms has been made at the Four Points by Sheraton Hotel in downtown Kingston. The rooms are available on a first come basis at \$155.00 for a queen or king size bed and \$185.00 for a suite. On-line reservation should be made before May 12th at
