**REGISTRATION**

This is a developmental tournament for fencers with a variety of experience from unclassified fencers to classification C fencers.

### **GENERAL:**

This event is sanctioned by the Ontario Fencing Association and all fencers need a Transitions OFA Membership and CFF License. You must have your membership and License at least 7 days prior to the event.

As a Category 3 Event, this Tournament will not be registered by the CFF for domestic rankings.

This tournament will be run in accordance with CFF and FIE rules and regulations subject to the interpretations of the Directoire Technique.

There may be mixed fencing in a weapon as dictated by numbers

All fencers are subject to Article t.15 of the FIE Rules and Regulations.  
Masks and body cords will be checked prior to the start of poules.

Weapon checks will occur on piste before the start of each match.

Regular fencing attire is required including an under-plastron which comply with current CFF regulations.

Electric Foil Bibs are required at this tournament.

Track pants are allowed instead of fencing breeches. Fencing breeches must be worn with long socks. Track pants must not have any openings along the legs (ex: pockets or buttons along the side of the pants), if so, they must be taped closed.

### **LOCATION AND DIRECTIONS:**

We are located at building #4 on the following map.

Parking is located outside the front of the facility, and behind the facility along Steeles Ave.

#### **From the 401:**

- 1) Take exit 362 to Keele St. North
- 2) Drive North on Keele St. to Steeles Ave. (6.7km)
- 3) Turn Left (West) on Steeles Ave. until Founder's Road (Traffic light about 200m after the turn)
- 4) At the roundabout, take the 1<sup>st</sup> exit on the right (Ian MacDonald Blvd)
- 5) At the next roundabout, take the 3<sup>rd</sup> exit on the right (350m) and into Thompson Road  
Optional Parking: At the roundabout, take the first exit on the right to reach an entrance on the right side of the road for additional parking.
- 6) Drive along the street, until you reach the front entrance of the building (opposite side of the building seen in Step 5).

#### **From the 400:**

- 1) Take exit 26 to Steeles Ave.
- 2) Turn Left (East) towards York University
- 3) Turn Right at "North West Gate" (2km)  
Optional Parking: There is an available parking lot entrance on the left side of the street about 10m after the initial turn into the North West Gate.
- 4) At the roundabout take the 2<sup>nd</sup> exit on the right
- 5) Drive along the street until you reach the front entrance of the building (opposite side of the building seen in step 4).
