



Veteran Circuit

The Veteran circuit is for Veteran athletes.

Format

The Veteran direct elimination competition, by category, is organized according to the results of the Veteran Open, if there are registered. Separate men's/women's age category DE events will be held if there are at least 4 fencers; otherwise, only a combined DE will be held.

- Open Veteran
- 50+ (ages 50 -59)
- 60+ (ages 60 - 69)
- 70+

Participants that enter in multiple events may be required to fence multiple bouts without breaks. Should conflicts arise, participants may be asked to withdraw from an event. Pools of 6 or 7. All events will have one round of pools, with all participants promoted.
