

Youth Circuit

This circuit is for Youth fencers. From U9 to U15 fencers.

Format

These events will teach athletes at a young age the expectations and decorum of competition fencing.

<u>The U11 and U9</u> will be mixed up resulting in 2 events in total. The format of the competition will be one round of pools (8 fencers or +) with 100% promotion. Advancement into Direct Elimination will be ranked on the results from the pools.

OFA rankings will be used for pools seeding.

Pool bout in 5 points / D.E bout in 8 points for U9 and 10 points for U11.

<u>U13 and U15</u> events with greater than six (6) competitors will be separated by gender The format of the competition will be one round of pools with 100% promotion. Advancement into Direct Elimination will be ranked on the results from the pools. OFA rankings will be used for pools seeding. Pool bout in 5 points / D.E bout in 15 points.

All competitors will be expected to know the rules of their specific events.

Note - Blades

U9 – size 0 - 2 blades required for Epee and Foil / Sabre – Plastic Sabre (provided by organizers)

- U11 size 0-2 blades required
- U13 no special rules regarding the maximum blade length

U15 – no special rules regarding the maximum blade length

Plastic Sabre for the U9 tournament (Provided by organizers).

Competitions awards

Medals will be awarded to the four top spots of the event. No fencing for third place.

Youth Provincials awards

<u>OFA Youth Circuit Badge Gold</u> for athletes ranked from 1st– 8th at the 2024 Youth Provincial Championships.

<u>OFA Youth Circuit Badge Silver</u> for athletes ranked from $9^{th} - 16^{th}$ at the 2024 Youth Provincial Championships.

<u>OFA Youth Circuit Badge Bronze</u> for athletes ranked from 17th– 32th at the 2024 Youth Provincial Championships.

Winners of the U13 and U15 OFA Rankings will receive Quest For Gold funding (Q4G - Ontario Ministry Program) at the end of the season. They must attend an OFA camp to be eligible for this funding.
